



Kamp Kidlets – Sr. Counsellor Positions

We are seeking energetic leaders for our Kamp Kidlets team!

Purpose of Senior Counsellors

Senior counsellors are accountable to work with Kamp Kidlets and the Original Kids Theatre (OKTC) administration to help evolve the vision of Kidlets through Original Kids mission. You will be responsible for working closely with the Kamp Director to assist in the day to day operations of Kamp Kidlets, supporting Kamp Kidlets counsellors and taking on supervisory roles.

Description of Responsibilities

1. Assisting in day to day operations
 - a. Setting up/running Kidlets before and after care, as well as daily sign in and sign out
 - b. Following a detailed operations schedule per one week sessions, provided by Kamp Director
 - c. Facilitating smooth transitions between Kamp activities
 - d. Participating in all activities (games, craft, etc)
 - e. Contributing to a positive Kamp environment and leading by example
 - f. Duties as assigned
2. Supporting Kamp Kidlets counsellors
 - a. Supervising kampers during staff breaks
 - b. Being available to answer questions or offer suggestions
 - c. Leading with a positive and kind attitude
 - d. Understanding and identifying moments of conflict when working with young children
 - e. Working and adapting to situations with our inclusion coordinator
3. Supervisory roles
 - a. Assist Kamp Director in planning and implementation of day to day camp operations.
 - b. Work with Original Kids inclusion coordinator to make Kamp Kidlets safe and fun
 - c. Supervise a pod of children.
 - d. Supervise a group of staff members throughout the summer.
 - e. Duties as assigned

Basic Qualifications

1. Must have experience working with children aged 5 to 8.
2. Candidates must be 18yrs of age or older by the start of camp. (July 2, 2024)
3. Must demonstrate passion and enthusiasm for working with young children.
4. Minimum 2 years of theatre experience.
5. Standard First Aid certification.
 - a. If you are not certified you will need to attend our training (June 8, 2024)
6. Police vulnerability screen at the candidate's expense.
7. Must be able to commit to **all** time commitments outlined below.
