Purpose of Counsellors

Counsellors are accountable to work with Kidlets and the Original Kids administration to help evolve the mission of Kidlets and Original Kids Theatre. They are responsible for working closely with the Kidlets Director and Sr. Counsellors to assist in the day to day operations of Kidlets.

Description of Responsibilities

- 1. Assisting in day to day operations
 - a. Setting up/running Kidlets + daily sign in and sign out assistance.
 - b. Following a detailed operations schedule per sessions, provided by Kidlets Director or Sr. Counsellors.
 - c. Facilitating smooth transitions between activites.
 - d. Participating in all activities (games, craft, etc).
 - e. Contributing to a positive environment and leading by example.
 - f. Duties as assigned.

2. Supervisory roles

- a. Assist Kidlets Director and Sr. Counsellors in planning and implementation of day to day camp operations.
- b. Supervise a rotational group of 8-12 children.
- c. Supervise a group of 4-5 staff members throughout the summer.
- d. Duties as assigned.

Basic Qualifications

- 1. Must have experience working with children.
- 2. Must demonstrate passion and enthusiasm for working with young children.
- 3. Minimum 2 years of theatre experience.
