Purpose of Counsellors

Counsellors are integral to a successful camp day. Counsellors at Camp OK will work alongside Campers, Staff, and the Camp OK! administration to carry out the mission and vision of Camp OK and Original Kids Theatre (OKTC). In this role, you will embody the values of Original Kids while working with every group at camp, including campers, Senior Staff and Camp OK administration to assist in the day-to-day operation of camp and the supervision of campers.

Description of Responsibilities

1. Assisting in day-to-day operations of camp:
 - a. Contributing to a positive Camp environment and leading by example
 - b. Facilitating sign-in and sign out with campers
 - c. Facilitating smooth transitions between camp activities
 - d. Leading activities throughout the day (games, dances, songs, etc.,)
 - e. Active participation in all activities (games, classes, afternoon shows, etc.,)
 - f. Duties as assigned.
2. Supervision roles
 - a. Supervising and engaging with campers during the day
 - b. Leading with a positive, kind, and welcoming attitude
 - c. Identifying conflicts amongst campers and seeking solutions alongside other staff members
 - d. Working and adapting to situations alongside fellow counsellors, senior staff, and Camp OK administration.
 - e. Duties as assigned.
3. Communication responsibilities
 - a. Responding to questions from parents and/or guardians regarding camp
 - b. Communicating with staff regarding the camp day
 - c. Duties as assigned.

Basic Qualifications

1. Must have experience working with children aged 7 – 16.
2. Candidates must have completed grade nine before the start of camp.
3. Must demonstrate passion and enthusiasm for working with children.

4. Minimum two years of theatre experience.
5. Must be available to commit to **all** time commitments outlined below.
