Camp OK: Senior Kid in Training (SKIT) Positions

The SKIT Program provides youth with the opportunity to volunteer their time at Camp OK to enhance their leadership skills and gain insight into what it means to be a Camp OK staff member. SKITs are not responsible for leading their own group of campers but rather supporting the larger group. SKITs are directly supervised by the SKIT Coordinator and Senior Counsellor of their respective groups.

Description of Responsibilities:

- 1. Working with the Camp OK Staff to deliver an excellent experience for our campers while assisting in day-to-day tasks.
 - a. Lead games and activities.
 - b. Facilitate washroom runs.
 - c. Assist in the supervision of campers.
- 2. Assist with the creation of each Camp OK show
 - a. Block scenes.
 - b. Choreograph dances.
 - c. Stage manage.
- 3. Communicate with campers, Camp OK Staff and families about the progression of Camp OK.

This is a volunteer position which lasts for one month. We offer two different cohorts, one in July (June 30 - July 25) and one in August (July 28 - August 22). If all work days are attended, SKITs will receive 130 volunteer hours for participating.

Basic Qualifications:

- 1. Have completed Grade 8.
- 2. Have not completed Grade 11.
- 3. Demonstrated verbal and written communication skills.

Preferred Qualifications:

- 1. Currently enrolled at Original Kids.
- 2. Have completed the Leaders in Training (LIT) Program at Camp OK.

Mandatory Training:

Two days of training will be completed in June (exact date TBA).
